

Turn over to have a go at making a paper boat - don't forget to give it a name!








## Fold a paper boat!


1. Take a piece of A4 paper and fold it in half.




4. Open out the 'hat' until you make a diamond, then fold it flat. You'll need to tuck in the corners.



2. Take the top corners, and fold them into the middle.




5. Fold the bottom corner up to the top corner on both sides.

3. Fold the bottom



6. Open out the shape to make another diamond



7. Pull the top corners out and you will see your boat taking shape. Flatten it out and you're ready to sail!
