Don Catchment History

Barnsley main is an old colliery. Coal used to be mined here.



This huge boat carried cargo from Rotherham to the Humber estuary. It is called the **Exol pride**.



Conisbrough viaduct is a huge bridge that goes over the river. Trains used to go over it.



Goole

The Boat inn in Sprotbrough is over 300 years old.



This church in Rotherham was built on a bridge that goes over the river Don. It is called "**Our lady of the Chapel on the bridge**"



Chesterfield's church is famous for its **crooked spire**.
